

PIKITUP PROVIDES A FREE BULKY WASTE COLLECTION SERVICE

Pikitup, the Waste Management Company of the City of Johannesburg provides a free bulky waste service to collect unwanted waste from households (e.g. old mattresses, old fridges, old furniture, etc) in an effort to deal with illegal dumping across the City.



The aim of this initiative is to divert recyclable material away from landfills (except for waste suitable for, and as required for use as daily cover material), thus increasing airspace and increasing the lifespan of the existing landfills.



Residents who want to dispose their bulky waste from their households are urged to contact their nearest Pikitup depots or use their nearest garden sites in their proximity. Once a resident has logged a call at any of the Pikitup's depots, the responsible Depot Manager will log a call and arrange for a free once-a-month bulky waste service to collect such waste.
